

public. This does not include food prepared from a common kitchen for all members.

- vii. Lemonade stands managed by preschoolers and school age children.
- viii. General cake sales: Limited to cake, cookies, candy, bread, prepackaged commercial goods, and non-cream pies.
- ix. Commercial packaged doughnuts and coffee provided at no charge as a courtesy service.
- x. Private homes where food is prepared or served for individual family consumption.
- xi. Markets which offer only fresh fruits and vegetables.
- xii. Any facility not required for licensing via Memorandum of Agreement between Montgomery County Health Department and Pennsylvania Department of Agriculture.

**Section 4-213    Application procedure for appropriate license**

Prior to the opening of a food facility, the operator shall contact the Department to obtain the appropriate application form for the required license. The Department will supply the applicant the appropriate license application form and plan review documents, based upon the type of food facility involved. Additional documentation shall be submitted as requested by the Department and as part of the application for a mobile food unit including but not limited to: commissary verification information, a copy of vehicle registration, and a list of vending locations.

**Section 4-214    Issuance**

- a. New, converted or remodeled food facilities - For food facilities that are required to submit plans as specified in section 4-208(a) (relating to facility and operating plans), the Department will issue a license to the applicant after the following occur:
  - i. The required plans, specifications and information are reviewed and approved.
  - ii. A preoperational inspection, as described in section 4-211 (relating to preoperational inspection of construction) shows that the facility is built or remodeled in accordance with the approved
